They will rotate through the various stations including: pailing, warehousing, vintage reactors, filling, mixing, bulk handling, hot cast, and dispersion. Additionally, they are responsible for cleaning vessels, basic machine maintenance and flammable storage area. Compensation is hourly, and vision, medical, life, dental, and 401K benefits are included.

Responsibilities

Level 1

- Setup of pailing station
- Stages materials needed for pailing daily
- Ensure pailing orders are fulfilled
- Responsible for the pailing area. Must keep neat and orderly
- Ensure stretch wraps are consistent and up to shipping standards
- Operation of computers, devices and machinery used in Chemical Blending and the proper handling and management of materials & products
 - Load specified amounts of chemicals into processing equipment
 - Monitor operating conditions
 - Cleaning reactors or vessels
- Packages and stocks finished product according to directives and procedures
- Follows step-by-step instructions to ensure product specifications are correct
 - Setting appropriate mixing speed
 - Setting temperature of reactor and transfer lines, as needed
 - Adding multiple materials as directed
 - Monitor operating conditions
 - Packages finished product according as directed
 - Fill tanker trucks and clean out tanker loading pipelines (Hot Cast Only)
 - Change Filter Bags Daily (Hot Cast Only)
- Handling bulk and small package raw materials

All Levels

- Assist with mechanical repairs, maintenance, and facility operation's upkeep
- Assist with planning & completion of projects
- Observes various safety precautions (PPE, LOTO, CSE)
 - Ensure the proper handling and management of materials & products
 - Notifies supervisor or maintenance of equipment malfunctions or concerns.
- ISO Responsibilities:
 - Ensure understanding of the Quality Policy and Quality Objectives
 - Ensure production process are followed consistently
 - Offer input for improvement of processes
 - Participate in investigations as needed

Level 2

- Ensure all transportation documentation is accurate for outgoing and incoming materials
- Unloading of bulk tanker trucks upon arrival
- Responsible for upkeep of area. Must keep clean and orderly
- Cleaning hoses as needed
- Transfers to outgoing bulk tanker trucks
- Dispose of waste as needed
- Process all tanker load outs

Level 3

- Ensure hot cast reactor, mixer, or disperser is prepped for each new product
 - Requires cleaning of reactors, vessels, pumps, valves, and transfers lines
 - Inspection of heat tracers to ensure proper temperatures are maintained, as needed →

Skills, Experience, & Requirements

- Teamwork.
- Experience making complex mixtures and compounds on multiple stations.
- Ability to work in tight areas and crawl underneath disperser, in order, to clean vessels and lines.
- Ability to multitask but maintain attention to details.
- Interface with DCS/Computer.
- Lift 50-70 lbs. objects climb a ladder to add ingredients (50-70 lbs.) to disperser.
- Operate multiple PIV's (fork trucks and lifts).
- Do math calculations.
- All candidates must undergo and pass a drug screening and a reference security check.
